

So many times in life when we are experiencing difficulties or things just aren't going well for us, we tend to blame God and wonder why we have to put up with so much adversity. Why must I suffer so much? Why doesn't God fix this? Why can't life be a bit easier?

A young boy began lessons with an old Japanese judo master. The boy was only ten years old and had lost his left arm in a car accident. But he really had a desire to learn judo - and learn it well enough to be a master himself some day. He was doing very well in his lessons, so he couldn't understand why, after three months of training, the master had taught him only one move. "This is the only move you'll ever need to know," the sensei replied.

Several months later, the sensei sensing the boy was ready for competition, took him to his first tournament. There he won all three matches. Still amazed by his own success, he found he was now in the finals. He asked the judo master why he had won.


"You won for two reasons," the sensei answered. "First, you've almost completely mastered one of the most difficult throws in all of judo. And second, the only known defense for that move is for your opponent to grab your left arm." The boy's biggest weakness had become his greatest strength.

We don't often view our weaknesses in life the same way, but we should - just like Paul prayed fervently for God to remove some difficult affliction unknown to us - what he called a "thorn in the flesh." Refusing to remove it, God said to Paul, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness."

Remind kids that God made each of us unique—just like no two snowflakes are alike! (Psalm 139:14, KJV)










