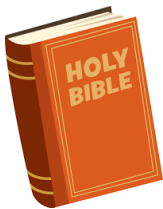

2026 MEAT CANNING PROJECT

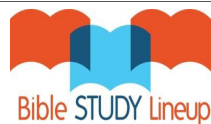
The 2026 "Meat Canning Project" processed a total of 9,516 two-pound cans of chicken.

You are invited to join one or more of these groups for Bible Study!

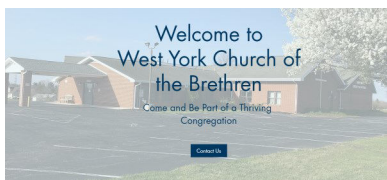
