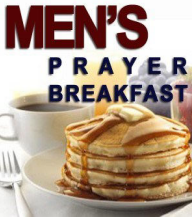

The “**Seeking Amazing Grace**” Adult Sunday School class continues to grow, numerically, but even more importantly, spiritually. We are studying the **book of James**.

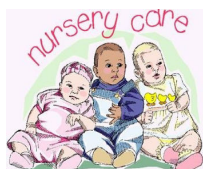

You are invited to join one or more of these groups for Bible Study!

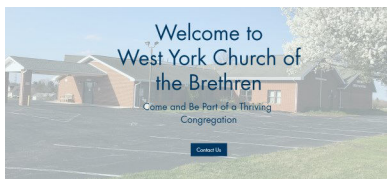
