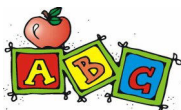
Steve & Nicole Grove have taken the opportunity to serve as our new Food Pantry coordinators.

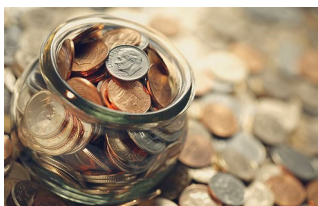

You are invited to join one or more of these groups for Bible Study!

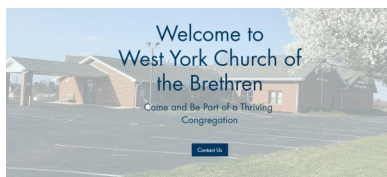
YARD SALE DONATIONS
