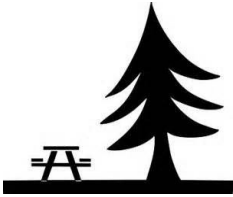

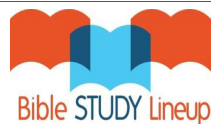

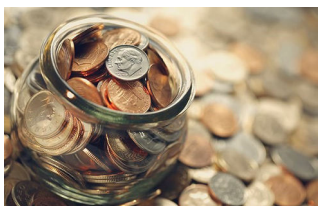

You are invited to join one or more of these groups for Bible Study!

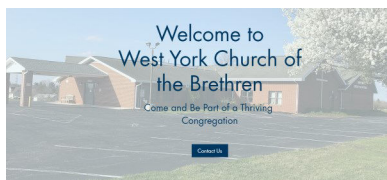
