



If you have a room in your house that does not get a lot of light, do you know how to brighten it up? Interior designers tell us that the best way to increase the light in a room is to add one or more mirrors in the room. One good mirror will double the amount of sunlight in the room by reflecting whatever sunlight does manage to get in.

Our world is, in many ways, like a dark room right now. To those unsaved, Jesus is like a bright beam of sunshine outside their lives. But we are the mirrors that can reflect His light to others. This is a Biblical metaphor. In John 9:5, Jesus said, “I am the light of the world.” But He also said in Matthew 5:14-16 that we are the light of the world. While Jesus is the true Light – the Source of all true light – we reflect His brilliance to a dark planet, very much in need of His light.

Isaiah 60:1-2 says “Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord rises upon you. See, darkness covers the whole earth and thick darkness is over the people, but the Lord rises upon you and his glory appears over you.”

As we begin a new year of ministry here at WYCOB, let’s ask Jesus to help us be a light in this dark world around us. We are called to bring that light that is outside the life of the unsaved individual; to bring it to bear on the inside of their life, so all can see the true Light that has come into the world.
