

"Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone.

Forgive as the Lord forgave you." Colossians 3:13

If you are having trouble getting over an insult, hurt, or injustice, here are two verses that may help. 1st Corinthians 13:5 says "love keeps no record of wrongs." Because God's most important command to us is to love, we have to take those grievances and hurts and give them to the Lord. In effect, it's like putting them in a fire and burning them to ashes and throwing them out; this putting them behind us.

Isaiah 43:18, 19 contains this counsel: "Forget the former things; do not dwell on the past. See I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland."

If someone has done you wrong, your anger might lead you to want to seek revenge. Refusing to forgive another for their transgressions can keep you bound by your anger. Choose today to forgive in the power of Jesus who has forgiven you, and thus free yourself from that kind of anger addiction. Burn those past grievances and go into the future knowing God is doing a new thing in your life.

I would encourage you to be in Worship in September. I am planning a short series of messages on some of the most difficult teachings of Jesus—from the Sermon on the mount—in Matthew 5—7. How do we handle these radically different - and difficult - words of instruction from Jesus to us?

I would also encourage you to check out the Adult Sunday School class Sunday mornings at 9:00 as we tackle challenging Scripture passages in light of the major current events happening in our society and culture today. It is really an exciting and interesting look at applying our faith to our daily life. Come, join us.

What you need:

- Plastic bag (large zippered)
- Permanent marker
- Bandage
- Toy plane
- Heart-shaped drawing or toy
- Spoon
- Coin
- Hot-sauce packet

What you do:

- 1. Label the bag with details about the missionaries you'll be praying for (names, location, specific needs).
- 2. Add small prayer-prompt objects to guide your prayer time (bandage = health, plane = travel, heart = relationships, spoon = cultural connection, coin = finances, hot sauce = boldness).
- Include other objects that will prompt prayer for missionaries' specific needs.
- 4. Place the bag where it will remind your family to pray regularly.

2023 SENIOR FARMERS MARKET NUTRITION PROGRAM

We have received information regarding this program from the York County Area Agency on Aging. It provides \$50 in vouchers to eligible seniors to buy fresh fruit and vegetables from participating local farm markets.

- Must be 60 yrs of age or older by December 31, 2023
